

MINUTES OF A COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON 11 FEB 1971 AT 8.0 pm AT THE
QUEENS HEAD CHISLEHURST.

Present; Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and Messrs Dowle, Birch and Johnson.

Apologies. Apologies were received from Mr Laver.

1. The Chairman opened the meeting and gave details of the change in Secretaries. The minutes of the AGM were discussed.

2. The Secretary reported that the minutes for the AGM and the demands for subscriptions had been delivered with the exception of 2 Marlowe Close, Kent Turf and Fairlawn.

3. The Treasurer referred to the delay in collecting subscriptions for 1970 and explained that illness had prevented him from following up his demands.

4. The Chairman referred to the £300 compensation paid for the upsetting of Kemnal Road. The sum of £50 would go to the General Road Fund and £250 would be ~~used to improve~~ the strip of land ~~adjacent~~ to Kemnal Road.

5. The condition of the footpath was discussed and the Chairman apologised to Mr Dowle for the delay in considering his tender. It was agreed that Mr Dowle would arrange for further tenders to be submitted.

6. Mr Birch said that he would have difficulty in collecting subscriptions for 1970 as the accounts at Mapledene were already closed. Mr Birch agreed to accept a demand for 1971 and that he would do his best for 1970. Discussion confirmed that the subscription year was the same as the calendar year.

7. The Tree Preservation Officer had been approached by Mr Dunn with reference to a tree which had been cut down. As he had received an unfavourable reply Mr Dunn informed the meeting that he would take the matter up with the Council.

8. Entrance to Ashfield Lane. Mr Dowle suggested that a sight line should be made across the corner plot. The Secretary was asked to write to the Borough Engineer.

9. Mr Dowle proposed extending the membership of the Kemnal Road Association. It was decided to leave this for the Annual General Meeting.

10. The Committee expressed their regret to Mr Johnson when he informed them that he was leaving Chislehurst.
