

Minutes of a Committee Meeting
held at the Queens Head
on 25th May, 1971

Present: Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary
Messrs. Johnson, Laver, MacMahon
and Maliphant.

Apologies were received from Mr. Dowle.

1. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and signed by the Chairman.
2. Matters arising.
 - (a) The Chairman reported on his visit to the Council in reference to a tree which had been felled in Kennal Road. The Council said that another tree would be planted in due course.
 - (b) The Secretary stated that the Council had confirmed that a sight line would be enforced at the junction of Kennal Road and Ashfield Lane.
3. Footpath.

The meeting discussed the cost of repairing the path and it was decided to leave a decision until the Annual General Meeting. At this point Mr. Laver referred to the dangerous curve in the road.
4. Building Contractors.

Mr. Maliphant suggested that the contractors who were building houses on the new site should be approached to make a donation of £100 to the K.R.R.A. It was agreed that the Treasurer should do this.
5. Subscriptions.

The Treasurer reported that money was not coming in very quickly. The Chairman suggested that a list of non-payers should be drawn up and that members of the Committee should contact these people.
6. Mapledene.

There was a long discussion on Mapledene's non-payment of road dues; Mr. Laver agreed that he would do his best to get this paid.

7. New houses - Kemnal Road.
