1) Damage by contractors vehicles:-

Mr Doule had written to the Secretary complaining that the building contractors were damaging the road surface and suggested that the developer be compelled to resurface a portion of it.

The Chairman read a letter re the parking of vehicles, and the making good ^{of} the trenches which had been made across the road, and that a claim for wear and tear would be discussed. Miss Allison James also referred to the difficulty experienced by the residents of Kemnal ^{Widren}; she had spoken to the site foreman but nothing had been done. The Chairman said that he had been in touch with the solicitor on this matter.

4. Mapledene. Mr Maliphant and Mr Laver reported that 16 houses were to be erected there and work would start in the Autumn. The Chairman agreed to bring the matter to the attention of the Chislehurst Resident Association if Mapledene so wished.
