5. The Chairman gave details of the meetings he had had with the developers of the Ryco houses and the builder of the bungalow near to Inglewood. The Committee had met the Ryco representative who agreed to make good the trenches across the road. The Chairman had arranged for our solicitors to get in touch with Ryco.

Mr. Childs suggested that road ramps should be constructed, and it was decided to call a committee meeting to consider the implications more fully.

6. Road Maintenance during 1972. Mr. Maliphant recommended another dressing coat and it was decided to go ahead and get tenders; although it was to be borne in mind that there were two building schemes either in hand or due to start.
7. Footpath. Miss Allison-James called attention to the condition of the pathway and the danger of overhanging branches.
8. The sight line at Ashfield Lane was discussed at some length; the Chairman had already reminded the Council that the rhododendrons had not yet been removed.
